COMPATIBILITY

ColourUp is compatible with most pesticides commonly used on vegetable, fruit and agronomic crops. Caution: Do not use with Dormant Oil, Lime, Sulphur, Spray Lime or highly alkaline spray materials. The use of *Nu-Film P®* or *Nu-Film 17®* will help control the foliar absorption of *ColourUp*. Do not use penetrating type surfactants or oils with *ColourUp*.
